Proposed Tax Levy (Additional) Sullivan Township

A majority affirmative vote is necessary for passage.

An additional tax for the benefit of Sullivan Township for the purpose of maintaining and operating cemeteries at a rate not exceeding 0.5 mill for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to \$0.05 for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for a continuing period of time, commencing in 2020, first due in calendar year 2021.

Proposed Tax Levy (Renewal) Ashland County

A majority affirmative vote is necessary for passage.

A renewal of a tax for the benefit of Ashland County for the purpose of the operation of Dale-Roy programs and facilities by the Ashland County Board of Developmental Disabilities at a rate not exceeding 2.1 mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to \$0.21 for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for 3 years, commencing in 2021, first due in calendar year 2022.

A renewal of a tax for the benefit of Ashland County for the purpose of providing mental health, alcohol and drug treatment and prevention programs by the Ashland County Alcohol, Drug Addiction and Mental Health Service District at a rate not exceeding 1 mill for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to \$0.10 for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for 5 years, commencing in 2021, first due in calendar year 2022.
