Village of Yellow Springs

A majority affirmative vote is necessary for passage.

A renewal of a tax for the benefit of the Village of Yellow Springs for the purpose of **current expenses** at a rate not exceeding 8.4 mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to \$0.84 for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for 5 years, commencing in 2021, first due in calendar year 2022.

Greene County Public Health

A majority affirmative vote is necessary for passage.

A renewal of a tax for the benefit of Greene County for the purpose of **providing sufficient funds to carry out its health programs including, but not limited to child and senior services, control of tuberculosis and communicable diseases, food and water protection, health education, safe communities, HIV/AIDS diagnosis and education and emergency preparedness and response** at a rate not exceeding 0.8 mill for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to \$0.08 for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for 5 years, commencing in 2021, first due in calendar year 2022.
