- Note the permitted number of choices directly below the title of each candidate office. Do not mark the ballot for more choices than allowed.
- If you mark the ballot for more choices than permitted, that contest or question will not be counted.
- **To vote for a write-in candidate:** completely darken the oval (●) to the left of the blank line and write in the candidates name.
Only votes cast for candidates who filed as write-in candidates can be counted.
- Do not write in a candidate's name if that person's name already is printed on the ballot for that same contest.
- **If you make a mistake or want to change your vote:** return your ballot to an election official and get a new ballot. You may ask for a new ballot up to two times.

PROPOSED TAX LEVY (RENEWAL)

HARRISON COUNTY PUBLIC CHILDREN SERVICES AGENCY

A majority affirmative vote is necessary for passage.

A renewal of a tax for the benefit of Harrison County for **the purpose of support of Children Services in the care and placement of children** at a rate not exceeding one-half (0.5) mill for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to five cents (\$0.05) for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for five (5) years, commencing in 2019, first due in calendar year 2020.

PROPOSED TAX LEVY (RENEWAL)

HARRISON COUNTY

A majority affirmative vote is necessary for passage.

A renewal of a tax for the benefit of Harrison County for **the purpose of police protection, including the payment of salaries for police personnel, providing, upgrading, and maintaining equipment by the sheriff's office** at a rate not exceeding three-quarter mill (3/4) mill for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to three-quarter (\$0.075) for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for five (5) years, commencing in 2019, first due in calendar year 2020.
