Instructions to Voter

- **To vote:** completely darken the oval (●) to the left of your choice.
- Note the permitted number of choices directly below the title of each candidate office. Do not mark the ballot for more choices than allowed.
- If you mark the ballot for more choices than permitted, that contest or question will not be counted.
- **To vote for a write-in candidate:** completely darken the oval (●) to the left of the blank line and write in the candidate's name. Only votes cast for candidates who filed as write-in candidates can be counted.
- Do not write in a candidate's name if that person's name already is printed on the ballot for that same contest.
- **If you make a mistake or want to change your vote:** return your ballot to an election official and get a new ballot. You may ask for a new ballot up to two times.
- **Please use a ballpoint pen.**

Hocking County

A majority affirmative vote is necessary for passage.

A renewal of a tax for the benefit of Athens-Hocking-Vinton Alcohol, Drug Addiction, and Mental Health Services District for the purpose of supplementing the general fund for operation, acquisition, construction, renovation and maintenance of mental health and recovery services and facilities at a rate not exceeding one mill for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to \$0.10 for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for 10 years, commencing in 2022, first due in calendar year 2023.

Proposed Tax Levy (Renewal)

Perry Township

A majority affirmative vote is necessary for passage.

A renewal of a tax for the benefit of Perry Township for the purpose of **fire protection; to provide protection against fire, to provide and maintain fire apparatus and appliances, buildings and sites for apparatus and appliances** at a rate not exceeding one (1) mill for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to ten cents (\$0.10) for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for five years, commencing in 2021, first due in calendar year 2021.

A renewal of a tax for the benefit of Hocking County for the purpose of **providing or maintaining senior citizens services or facilities through the Scenic Hills Senior Center** at a rate not exceeding one-half (0.5) mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to five cents (\$0.05) for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for five years, commencing in 2022, first due in calendar year 2023.
